Projects planned for 2014 include but are not limited to: Forest Planning and Stand Assessments Strategic assessment of 25-50 year old plantations and second growth stands, including the development of treatment recommendations Silvicultural projects for the enhancement of forest productivity Forest inventory **Operations and Silvicultural Obligations** Road maintenance Mechanical brushing and other silvicultural treatments as needed Silvicultural surveys and assessments Forest Research Installation and re-measurement of various research trials Assist diverse research projects as needed **Educational Programs and Infrastructure** Design and layout for various forestry demonstration sites. Maintain and upgrade trail system Hosting of various tours and educational events **Job Requirements** This internship is a non-union, full-time predominantly field-oriented term position based from Prince George, British Columbia (7 months). Due to external funding support criteria, the position is restricted to university or college (technical) students currently enrolled or graduating this year with a natural resources management – forestry program or closely related program. The workweek is 40 hours, usually Monday through Friday, although modified work schedules may be required from time to time. This position is strongly team-oriented, and requires a broad range of interests related to the job duties. Applicants are expected to have experience or knowledge related to forest mensuration, silviculture, plant identification, forest soils, and forest management practices. Forestry experience or focus in Northern BC will be an asset. The successful applicant will be selfmotivated and enthusiastic. Strong attention to detail and effective communication skills are essential. Demonstrated experience leading teams is an asset.
